MED-DESIRE Project Supports in Developing An Innovative Financing Mechanism for Municipalities

- Representatives of all 9 members of the EU-funded MED-DESIRE project attended the project's last meeting held in Beirut between 16 and 19 September 2014. MED-DESIRE aims at removing barriers related to the legal, regulatory, economic and organizational framework of distributed solar energy technologies in the Mediterranean region. During the Beirut meeting, the project initiated the work towards developing an innovative financing mechanism for municipalities to spread distributed solar energy technologies in Lebanon. This activity will be managed by the Italian Ministry for the Environment, Land and Sea and will be conducted by three Lebanese energy experts. MED-DESIRE is led by "Regione Puglia" from Italy and includes partners from Italy, Spain, Tunisia, Egypt, and Lebanon. LCEC Publishes an Updated List of Qualified SWH Companies/ Products

- LCEC has recently finalized the evaluation of solar water companies working in Lebanon. The results of the evaluation are now published in the 10th version of the "List of Solar Water Heaters Suppliers/ Installers". This last evaluation has categorized companies and products into three different categories: "Passing Companies", "Qualified Companies" and "3-Star Companies". Companies and products listed under the "3-Star" and "Qualified" categories would benefit from the 200 USD grant offered by the Ministry of Energy and Water on solar water heater systems.
