National Workshop to Develop the New NEEAP 2015-2020

- With the support of the EU-funded MED-ENEC project, the national workshop “Evaluation and Update of the Lebanese National Energy Efficiency Action Plan (NEEAP)” was held in Beirut on 18 November 2014. The event gathered more than 50 representatives of the main players in the energy efficiency sectors, including ministries, public administrations, NGO’s, as well as UNDP, ESCWA, the SISSAF project. This first brainstorming event is the first step towards the development of the new Lebanese NEEAP 2015-2020. The NEEAP will be built according to the EU guidelines and format thanks to the support of the MED-ENEC and the team of international consultants of Ecofys. Future milestones will follow to ensure a wider participation of all parties in the development of this strategic document.
