A selection committee made of a number of local and regional experts will be selecting the winners. New International Standards on Implementation of Solar Photovoltaic Modules

- The decentralized solar photovoltaic market in Lebanon is witnessing a huge growth, mainly due to the momentum created by the Central Bank's NEEREA financing mechanism. As part of its efforts to increase the quality of products and installation services in Lebanon, the LCEC will be launching a new memo (M15-2-V1) regarding the requirement of certificates of conformity to international standards with solar modules to be installed under the NEEREA financing mechanism. The memo will be published soon and includes the standards (IEC 61215, IEC 61646, and IEC 61730) that should be applied. The LCEC, and within the MED-DESIRE project co-funded by the EU's ENPI CBC MED programme, is also working with LIBNOR to adopt these standards, among others, at the national level. To allow a grace period for market adaptation, the memo will not be enforced before a period of three months. More details on this issue will be discussed during the upcoming International Beirut Energy Forum 2015.
